Hey, who wants to go for a ride? What's that you say; it's December and cold outside! Well, it's not summer anymore, but that's not always a stop sign. When I lived up North we often rode until the temps got ridiculously low or the snow and ice showed up. We had a shorter riding season and had to make the most of it.

Planning for cold weather riding is fairly simple. Prep your bike, then prep yourself. Check your bike's tires often in cold weather because cooler temperatures will lower the pressure as the air contracts inside your tires. Allow extra time for your tires to warm up before attempting hard braking and cornering. Check your owners' manual to see if you may need to change your oil to a different weight for colder weather usage.

Beware of black ice on the road surface which is a riding surprise you'll never forget! If you contact black ice maintain a relaxed grip on the handlebars and avoid sudden steering inputs until you clear the affected stretch of pavement.

Keeping your body warm can be done in various ways while still maintaining freedom of movement. Base layer underclothes and layering other clothing such as flannel lined jeans and a flannel shirt are sound additions to your cold weather riding gear. Of course, a well insulated riding jacket that fits well is a necessity. These items combined with heated grips and a heated seat may be all you need. Others prefer to use heated gear like vests, heated pants, heated jackets and heated gloves.

Make sure your bikes' electrical system can handle the extra power that these options require.

One last tip, pay attention to those signs that say "BRIDGE FREEZES BEFORE ROAD" because they really do! The wind rushing under and over a bridge cools rthe structure more quickly than the roads leading up to it. When the snow comes, it's time to park it!

Technical Article on How to Tell the Age of Your Tires:

Tires should be changed every 6 years regardless of how much tread is on them. To tell the age of your tires look on the side for 4 numbers such as 4012 which means that this tire was made the 40th week of 2012 which would make this tire 5 years old and should be replaced next year. What you need to watch for when ordering tires from warehouses or individuals it that you do not buy a tire that is over 6 years old. Often these tires are priced very low.
