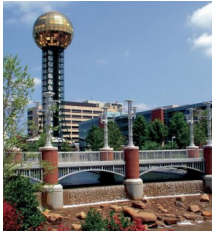

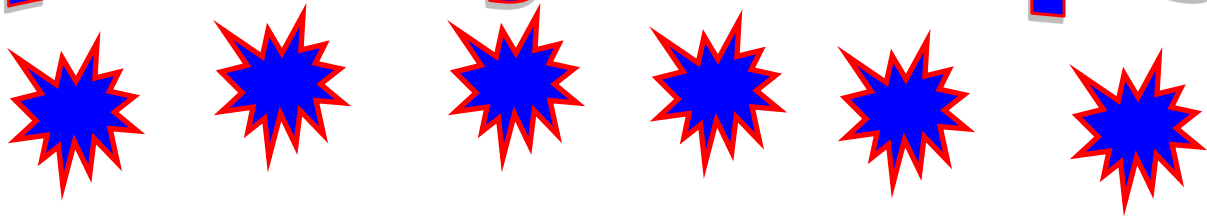

BAKED PINEAPPLE

1 large can pineapple chunks (drained)
2 T. sugar
2 T. cornstarch
1 beaten egg
Dash of salt

Cook the above over low heat until thick.

HEAVENLY LEMON BARS

Crust: 1 cup butter
1/2 cup powdered sugar
2 cups sifted flour

Mix together and form like a pie crust.
Flatten into a 9x13 pan.
Bake 15 minutes at 350.

Top: 4 eggs
4 T. lemon juice
4 T. flour
2 c. sugar
2 T. lemon rind
1 t. baking powder

Mix and pour over baked crust and bake at 350 for 20-25 minutes, until lightly browned.
Sprinkle with light dusting of powdered sugar and cut into squares.

How to bleed the brakes on a Goldwing Trike using Speed Bleeders

I met this mechanic, who works on a lot of brakes systems doing upgrades and he was telling that using speed bleeders was the way to go in place of the regular bleed screws on your brake calipers and how much quicker it was. I did some research online and found the correct size of bleeders for my Goldwing and Hannigan trike. It's a little work getting setup to do. You must remove the rear wheels to access the rear calipers and remove the front part of the front fender and caliper covers. I removed the bleeder screws, this includes the anti-dive bleeder. With this done you get a piece of plastic tubing to cover the end of the bleeder screw so that you will not spray brake fluid on your plastic parts. Place one end of the plastic tubing in a bottle with a little brake fluid in it and then open the speed bleeder a $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ turn and start pumping the brakes according to the sequence in the Honda manual. After three or four pumps close off the bleeder and the pedal will start to get firm. What I like about these bleeder screw is that we cannot always have some to help us for quite a while until all the air is out of the lines. You need to keep an eye on the brake reservoir as not to pump it dry of fluid.
