Happy Trails , May 2019

With everybody's bikes in shape after last week's tech day are you sure you're ready for the riding season? You do a T-CLOCS inspection before heading out on the road, but are YOU in the the proper mindset to ride? Before you ride, ask yourself "Am I READY?"

1. RELAXED and in the right mindset for riding. Are you angry, stressed, distracted or tired? These conditions are not good for riding. Assess your mental and emotional state before getting on your bike.

2. EQUIPPED with proper riding gear. Remember to wear ALL the gear ALL the time! Have an extra long sleeved shirt available should the temperature drop and be sure to have a rain suit packed.

3. ANTICIPATE the ride ahead. Think about what to expect on your ride. Weather & road conditions, the day of the week regarding traffic patterns, etc. Thinking ahead minimizes surprises.

4. DRUG & alcohol free. The best bet is to save drinking until the ride has ended for the day. If you're taking any medications, be aware of any side effects that may impair your riding ability.

5. YIELDING to more aggressive drivers. Maintaining control of a situation sometimes means giving in to aggressive drivers, some of which don't like motorcyclists in the first place. Engaging with them puts them in control. Remember, in this sense, SIZE MATTERS! Decide before you ride how you, or your group will respond to antagonistic drivers.

Keep these tips in mind before every ride and your trip should be more enjoyable.

May is Brain Tumor awareness month and also Motorcycle awareness month. Please tell your family and friends to look twice to save a life.

Honda Goldwing Electrical I was dealing with a customer's motorcycle the other day with electrical problems with some accessories they had added it was a maze of wires going here and there no fuses bare wires and potential fire hazard going down the road .This got me thinking about an article I once read on the Goldwing forums about a local company called The Electrical Connection which is a company that specializes in Honda Goldwing Parts. I reached out to them and asked if I could discuss two of the products with the group, so with their permission here are the 2 items every Goldwing owner should look at when adding accessories to their motorcycle. The first one is a power block assembly which hooks directly

to the battery. it is relay powered on when you turn on the key; this protects all accessories you add up to 6.

Next is the ground block that they developed to give you safe place to hook up a ground and create s good connection

Description

With new motorcycles using materials other than steel for the frame, questions have arisen as to what may or may not be a good quality ground. To easily answer the question comes the Master Ground Block.

It provides 8 individual terminals for connection of ground which can be double or tripled stacked. We attach 24" of 10 gauge high current cable and include a ring terminal for termination. Also included are wires ties for installation and 8 ring terminals for ground attachment.




This cost \$29.95


